

# Author's Guidelines of Journal of Korean Academy of Advanced General Dentistry

Journal of Korean Academy of Advanced General Dentistry (JKAAGD) is the official peer-reviewed, biannual publication of the Korean Academy of Advanced General Dentistry (KAAGD). It is circulated to all members of KAAGD and consists of original research, clinical articles, reviews, case reports, and other materials on dental science and related subjects.

If the manuscript didn't belong to the type listed above, an authorized publication committee has the right to deliberate about 'publication allowed' or 'publication not allowed'.

## ■ Aim and Scope

Journal of Korean Academy of Advanced General Dentistry (JKAAGD) is the official publication of the Korean Academy of Advanced General Dentistry. It was first launched in August 2012 (ISSN 2287-559x) and is published in August every year. As an open access, peer reviewed journal, JKAAGD aims to publish clinical and scientific research papers based on evidence-based investigations within all areas of contemporary dental practice. The journal publishes original research articles, review articles, case reports, technical reports, and short communications from the readers in subjects related with comprehensive dentistry.

## ■ Manuscript Submission

Submitted manuscripts must be written in Korean or English. Manuscripts are subject to peer review process followed by editorial revision. For consideration of publication in JKAAGD, authors should follow the submission guidelines below. By submitting a paper authors agree that the work has not been published before and is not being considered for publication elsewhere. Each reader must determine whether to act on the information contained in the

publication, and neither JKAAGD nor its sponsoring organizations shall be liable for any injury or damage occurred due to the publication of erroneous information.

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Manuscripts will normally be reviewed by the editor-in-chief and at least two reviewers with expertise within the scope of the article. The final publication decision lies with the Editorial Board. Accepted manuscripts will be copy edited according to the Journal style and returned to the author for approval before publication.

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The manuscript should be composed in this order; title, author(s), abstract, key words, material and methods, result, discussion, conclusion, references, legends for illustrations and figures.

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Put the title of the article, and include all the information pertaining to the author(s) such as full names(s) of author(s), academic degrees, institutional affiliations and positions; identify the corresponding author and include an address, telephone, fax numbers and an e-mail address. State the source of research funding, if any, at the lower part.

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A structured abstract of 250~300 words or less is preferred. Briefly state the purpose of the study, materials and methods, result and conclusion. At the bottom of the abstract, provide up to less than six keywords that best describe the content of the study. Select them preferably from the list of Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) used by the National Library of Medicine.

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Describe the experimental design procedures and material/subjects used. Give the details only if the methods are original or essential for understanding; otherwise, give references. Patients, tested animals and the control group should be stated clearly. In particular, the means to identify the subject disease and to control the author's subjective views should be explained. The names and manufacturers of the devices, materials and reagents for the test should be included in parenthesis. The authors should describe the generic name, dosage, and administration method of drug and chemical agents used. The patients' private information should not be exposed. The human study and animal research should be approved by local ethics committee. Indicate the statistical methods used, if applicable.

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### ■ Publication of the JKAAGD

JKAAGD is published at the 30th of April and the 31st of August.
